

## **350** Silicon Valley

#### **CA policy GHG reduction machine**





- Gears: AB32 (2006 Global Warming Solns Act), Cap & Trade (super gear), vehicle GHG standard, low carbon fuel standard, Guv exec orders, renewables, solar roofs, efficiency, regional transport, recycle, reduce waste, water, agriculture, forests. Comprehensive!
  - "AB32 Scoping Plan" controls the machine. Updated every 5 years
- Knob: low to high GHG cuts
  - Exxon: wants slow, current: faster than rest-of-world, moral: extremely fast
- Historic government accomplishment! Amazing cross-departmental collaboration. Amazing legislation
- · Very fragile. Major battle looms
  - 75% of CA voters oppose a \$0.25 gas tax increase (similar to a \$25/ton carbon price)
     Voters only support climate protection without personal impact.



#### What strategy?

- Protect CA policy, spread to US. Given US, rest of world will follow.
- Given gridlock, what US tactics? Is there empirical evidence?
   Book with international dataset of citizen movements
- If 3.5% population participate, 80% achieve systemic change
  - Important to discredit the opposition
    - Stigmatize Koch/Exxon
    - Apply sustained economic pressure
  - 3.5% is 11M Americans
- Expect strong countermeasures.





#### Pitch: Spread CA's Amazing Climate Protection Nationally

- Request: Ongoing Community discussion
   Every member spends at least a few hours/year
- 4 collaborative actions in 2 years. Start small.



# Result: Nov 2015 11M Americans demand climate policies. Laws are passed. Like 60's Civil Rights Movement? Inspiring or scary? Moral obligation / Golden Rule trumps invisible hand (short-term selfishness).



#### Action 2: Nov 2014

- 36 entities, 2,000 people (Action #1 squared)
- Step 3: Spring 2015 Bigger still
- Step 4: Nov 2015 win!

- 2. Should community undertake bold activism?
  - How many will participate?
- 3. Is there an effective action with high chance of "success?"
  - Mischievous, clever, savvy, lawful, strategic, fun?
- 4. Will things go back to normal the next day?
  - Who is willing to go to jail?
- 5. Is social justice well-considered?
